



Note: If tTG and DGP negative and biopsy suggests celiac disease, celiac disease is somewhat likely if other causes of enteropathy have been ruled out. If both serology and biopsy are negative, celiac disease is unlikely.

* Some physicians may ask for endomysial titer by IFA testing. According to the National Institutes of Health Consensus Development statement, IgA-tTG and IgA-EmA tests have equivalent diagnostic accuracy.
